

The Legacy Chivari Ballroom Chair

1



Pour glue into four holes on the hind legs.

4



Ensure the support bars are securely pushed into the holes and lined up so that the paint lines match up to avoid bare wood being visible.

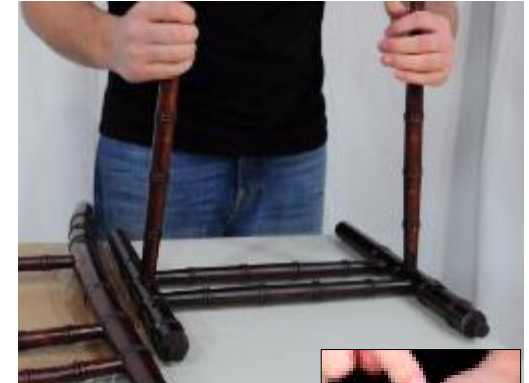


Pour glue into Four holes on the front legs.



Carefully pick up the front legs with the 4 support bars, turn it over, and push the support bars into the holes in the hind legs.

Insert 4 support bars into the glued holes. Ensure the support bars with metal rods are the bottom rung of the chair.

Apply glue to the two large holes under the seat pad.

Carefully lift your assembly, turn over, and push the front legs into the two glued holes.

8



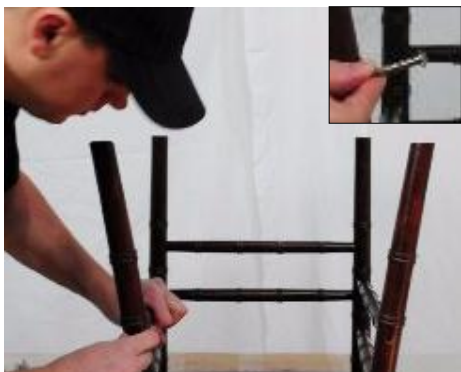
Insert the 2 nuts, with the line facing up, into the two holes under the seat pad.

9



Take the 2 long bolts, slide through hind leg and seat pad, into the nut and tighten with allen key.

10



Insert 4 medium size bolts through leg and into support bar. Thread into metal rod and tighten with allen key.

11



Place bracket holes over the pre-drilled holes on the seat pad and front leg. Using the small screws, fasten the brackets to the chair.
